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Subject: **FINANCIAL ALLOCATION FOR TRAFFIC CONGESTION RELIEF PROGRAM PROJECTS
RESOLUTION TFP-07-01**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve Resolution TFP-07-01, reallocating \$3,021,000 in previously allocated Traffic Congestion Relief Program (TCRP) funds for the project identified on the attached vote list.

ISSUE:

TCRP funds are available for expenditure for five years. However, with the previous suspension of Proposition 42, some TCRP projects were unable to proceed. Proposition 42 has been restored and this project is ready to proceed, but TCRP funds are in danger of lapsing and must be reallocated before the project can continue.

BACKGROUND:

Section 3.3 of the TCRP Guidelines states allocated TCRP funds are available for expenditure and reimbursement for up to five years after the date of the allocation.

TCRP funding is derived from Proposition 42. However, this funding was partially suspended in FY 2003-04 and fully suspended in FY 2004-05 in response to the fiscal crisis experienced by the State at that time. In response to the future availability of TCRP funds being in doubt, both applicant and implementing agencies decelerated the expenditure rate of some projects and/or in some cases suspended all activities pending future funds becoming available. In FY 2005-06, Proposition 42 funds were restored and projects are once again proceeding.

Initial allocations of TCRP funds were made beginning in September 2000. The unspent portions of those early allocations started to expire in September 2005. Projects ready to continue are at risk of further delays and incurring higher costs if these expiring allocations are not reallocated.

The following project is ready to proceed and will continue to need the remaining balance of previously allocated TCRP funds that otherwise set to expire at the end of July 2007:

- \$3,021,000 –Project #25.3 – Interstate (I)-80/I-680/State Route (SR) 12 Interchange in Fairfield in Solano County; SR 12 Interchange complex in seven stages (Stage 1).

Approval of the reallocation request extends the availability of the TCRP funds, allowing the TCRP project identified above to continue to expend funds beyond the current five-year time limit.

Justification:

As work for the environmental assessment progressed, the Department required the Solano Transportation Authority to complete three separate, independent studies to supplement the environmental document for the I-80/I-680/SR 12 Interchange project. These three separate studies required a significant amount of time to prepare and complete, and are essential components to ensure a comprehensive assessment of the I-80/I-680/SR 12 Environmental Impact Report/ Environmental Impact Statement (EIR/EIS). TCRP funds are necessary to complete the EIR/EIS for this project and will be used to complete the Project Approval and Environmental Document phase of this project. The draft EIR/EIS is scheduled to be released for public comment in the summer of 2008.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved That:

The project(s), as component phases or in their entirety, appear under Government Code Section 14556.40(a) and are entitled to participate in this allocation.

Reimbursement of eligible costs is subject to the policies, restrictions and assurances as set forth in the Commission's policy for allocating, monitoring, and auditing TCRP projects, and is governed by the terms and conditions of the Fund Transfer Agreement, Program Supplement or Cooperative Agreement, and subsequent amendments to the same if required, as executed between the Implementing Agency and the Department.
