## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission approve a technical correction to Resolution MFP-06-19, originally approved on June 7, 2007, for nine locally administered State Transportation Improvement Program Rail/Transit projects for \$24,356,000.

## **ISSUE:**

A technical correction is needed for Project #6 – Rolling Stock Maintenance Facility in San Bernardino (PPNO 3201) to add a notation to show that the project was programmed under and funded from the Los Angeles County’s Regional Improvement Program. No change to the amount allocated.
