Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below are not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all right, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. Consequently, the facility has been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

Resolution No. R-3671 ó 4-CC-123-PM 0.0/2.1
(Request No. 56082) ó 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of El Cerrito, between the southerly city limit line and State Route 80, consisting of nonmotorized transportation facilities, namely sidewalks. The City, by cooperative agreement dated February 28, 2006, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Request No. R120027) ó 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim, at the intersection of Chippewa Avenue and Crescent Avenue, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992, and by amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired August 7, 2007, without exception.
