Subject: **VACATION RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve Vacation Resolution A-866.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that the facility in the vacation resolution summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by vacation. The local agency was given a 90-day notice of relinquishment, without protesting such action. Upon the recording of the approved vacation resolution in the county where the facility is located, the public's right of use of the facility will be abandoned. Consequently, this vacation complies with Sections 892, 8313 and 8330.5 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual recommendation.
