RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission), as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-08-03.

ISSUE:

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) has been completed:

- Interstate 80 in Sacramento County – Construct new Bus/Carpool lanes near Sacramento.

This project in Sacramento County would construct Bus/Carpool lanes bypass along a portion of Interstate 80 near Sacramento. The project is not fully funded. The project is currently funded for Project Approval/Environmental Document and Plans, Specifications, and Estimates for \$9 million in Congestion Mitigation Air Quality funding. The total estimated project cost, capital and support, is \$200 million. Construction is estimated to begin in Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-12, depending on the availability of funds.

A copy of the FEIR has been provided to Commission staff. Potential issues with the Sacramento Air Quality Management District regarding construction emissions and the project's public controversy resulted in an Environmental Impact Report being completed for this project.

The Department has approved this project for construction. This approval and the filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.


