## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission approve technical corrections to the attachments to Resolution FP-06-101 and Resolution FP-07-39, originally approved on June 7, 2007 and December 13, 2007, respectively.

## **ISSUE:**

A technical correction is needed for each resolution attachment to correct the implementing agency for the Old Highway 99 Rehabilitation Project (Project #13 under Resolution FP-06-101 and Project #8 under Resolution FP-07-39), from the Siskiyou County Transportation Commission to Siskiyou County.
