## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following resolution, allocating \$35,847,000 for one multi-programmed Corridor Mobility Improvement Account (CMIA) and State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) project on the State Highway System to be funded \$26,573,000 from the CMIA and \$9,274,000 from the Transportation Facilities Account (TFA).

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes one State-administered CMIA and STIP project on the State Highway System totaling \$35,847,000, plus \$29,581,000 from other sources. The Department is ready to proceed with this project and is requesting an allocation at this time.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$26,573,000 be allocated from Budget Act of 2007, Budget Act Item 2660-304-6055 and \$9,274,000 be allocated from Budget Act Item 2660-304-6058 for one State-administered CMIA and STIP project, as described on the attached vote list.

The Department has complied with the National Environmental Policy Act and the California Environmental Quality Act requirements in preparing this project.
