Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. The facility is safe and drivable, or has been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3696 – 4-Sol-113-PM 19.0/19.8 (Request No. 56072) – 15 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Dixon, between West Chestnut Street and 0.1 mile north of West F Street, consisting of non-motorized transportation facilities, namely sidewalks. The City, by letter dated May 16, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3697 – 4-Sol-80-PM R27.4/R27.6 (Request No. 56084) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Vacaville, on the southeast side of East Monte Vista Avenue, between Browns Valley Parkway and the west bound State Route 80 off ramp, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by resolution dated December 7, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3698 – 6-Mad-99-PM 9.42(Request No. 85938) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Madera, on Almond Avenue easterly of South Gateway Drive, consisting of a reconstructed and relocated city street. The City, by resolution dated April 16, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3699 – 7-LA-5-PM R55.6, 7-LA-126-PM R5.7(Request No. 1233) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Los Angeles, on The Old Road at 0.1 mile north of the Route 126 Freeway, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The County, by letter dated October 2, 2007, and by letter dated April 10, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3700 – 8-SBd-83-PM 11.1/14.3(Request No. 461-S) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Upland, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement, dated October 17, 2007, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 507, Statutes of 2006, which amended Section 383 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution R-3701 – 8-SBd-210-PM 16.02/18.28(Request No. 454-S) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Rialto, on West Easton Street, between the west city limit line and North Ayala Drive, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city streets and frontage roads. The City, by memorandum of understanding dated May 6, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3702 – 10-SJ-120-PM 16.6/17.3(Request No. 15766) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Escalon, on McHenry Avenue, Escalon Bellota Road, and Yosemite Avenue, consisting of superseded highway and reconstructed and relocated city streets. The City, by joint powers agreement dated June 1, 1998, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3704 – 3-ED-50-PM 72.7(Request No. 035577-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of El Dorado, between Elks Club Drive and Sawmill Road, consisting of state highway right of way, for the purpose of constructing a bike path. The County, by resolution dated May 13, 2008, and by letter dated May 16, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
