Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. The facility is safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3727 – 04-Sol-37-PM 8.5, 9.2/10.4

(Request No. 56086) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Vallejo along Route 37 from Sacramento Street to Antioch Drive, consisting of superseded highway right of way, relocated or reconstructed city streets and a bike path. The City, by cooperative agreement dated February 24, 2009, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3728 – 06-Fre-180-PM 53.60/54.58

(Request No. 85387) – 6 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Fresno along Route 180 from South Brawley Avenue to South Marks Avenue, consisting of superseded highway right of way and collateral facilities. The County, by cooperative agreement dated May 24, 2005, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3729 – 06-Fre-43-PM 5.34

(Request No. 86343) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Fresno along Route 43 on Conejo Avenue, consisting of a reconstructed county road. The County, by resolution dated October 28, 2008, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3730 – 03-Pla-49-PM 2.52/3.08

(Request No. 035800-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Auburn on Route 49, under terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment agreement dated April 14, 2009, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 635, Statutes of 2008, which amended Section 349 of the Streets and Highways Code.
