Subject: **STIP AMENDMENT 08S-054**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve 2008 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Amendment 08S-054. This item was noticed at the Commission's August 12-13, 2009 meeting.

ISSUE:

The Department proposes to amend the 2008 STIP to delete \$11,229,000 in Interregional Improvement Program (IIP) Transportation Enhancement (TE) from eight projects and add \$10,470,000 in IIP TE to 13 projects.

BACKGROUND:

On June 11, 2009, the Commission approved Resolution FS-08-11 allocating \$10,764,000 for 12 TE projects funded from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Recovery Act). Subsequently, the Federal Highway Administration informed the Department that more investigation is needed to determine if these funds can be used for Conservation Corps projects. There is an urgent need to move forward with these shovel ready projects, so the Department is proposing an alternative course of action. The Department is proposing to reduce the amount programmed in the STIP for several TE projects (Attachment 1) in order to free up capacity for the TE projects previously allocated from, or planned for funding from, the Recovery Act. In turn, the projects previously planned for funding from the Recovery Act (Attachment 2) will be amended into the STIP for future allocation.

Specifically, the Department proposes the following actions in order to free up STIP programming capacity.

1. Delete the Rural Roadside Archaeological Inventory project (PPNO 0227J) in Riverside County for \$36,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2011-12 and \$1,369,000 in FY 2012-13. (To be backfilled with Recovery Act TE.)
2. Delete the California & Pony Express Auto Tour Route project (PPNO 9815) in various counties for \$136,000 in FY 2010-11 and \$363,000 in FY 2011-12. (To be backfilled with Recovery Act TE.)

3. Eliminate FY 2009-10 and FY 2010-11 programming on four additional TE projects. (To be backfilled with Recovery Act TE.)
4. Program \$10,470,000 in FY 2009-10 for 13 TE projects previously proposed for funding from the Recovery Act.

There is a concurrent item to rescind Recovery Act TE projects previously allocated on June 10, 2009, under Resolution FS-08-11, as the projects are now proposed to be programmed in the STIP.

RESOLUTION:

Be it Resolved, that the California Transportation Commission does hereby amend the 2008 State Transportation Improvement Program to change the programming as described above and illustrated in the following Attachments.
