**Ref: PROPOSITION 1B STATE-LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM
2009-10 Competitive Program Project Applications**

SUMMARY:

Proposition 1B, passed in November 2006, authorized \$1 billion for the State-Local Partnership Program (SLPP). The program is split into two sub-programs – a formula program to match local sales tax, property tax and/or bridge tolls (95%) and a competitive program to match local uniform developer fees (5%). The Legislature appropriated \$200 million in 2009-10 for the second year of this program, and the Commission is required by statute to adopt a program and make the first allocations by October 2009.

The Commission adopted SLPP Guidelines for 2009-10 in July 2009. These guidelines required applications for the second year of the program be submitted no later than August 15, 2009.

Commission staff has received 30 project applications for the competitive portion of the program totaling \$23,500,000. The amount available for programming in 2009-10 is \$9,986,000. The projects are shown on the attached list, in order of construction start date.

Staff expects to bring a proposed competitive program of projects for adoption by the Commission in October 2010. The Commission may decide, however, to defer adopting a program due to the lack of bond fund availability. The appropriated funds would remain available for programming in a future year.

BACKGROUND:

The Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006, approved by the voters as Proposition 1B on November 7, 2006, authorized \$1 billion to be deposited in the State-Local Partnership Program Account to be available, upon appropriation by the Legislature, for allocation by the California Transportation Commission over a five-year period to eligible transportation projects nominated by an applicant transportation agency.

In 2008, the Legislature enacted implementing legislation (AB 268) to add Article 11 (commencing with Section 8879.66) to Chapter 12.491 of Division 1 of Title 2 of the Government Code. This defines the program, eligibility of applicants, projects and matching funds.
