Subject: **TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO PREVIOUSLY APPROVED RESOLUTION -  
RESOLUTION FP-08-52**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve a technical correction to Resolution FP-08-52, originally approved June 11, 2009, to change the fund type for Project 2 - Newman Downtown Plaza Improvement project (PPNO 0218) in Stanislaus County, from TIF (Transportation Improvement Fund) to regional American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Recovery Act) and add Resolution FS-09-18.

## **ISSUE:**

The Newman Downtown Plaza Improvement project (PPNO 0218) construction is currently programmed in, and allocated from, the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for \$516,000. A technical correction is needed to revise the funding source from 100 percent STIP to 100 percent Recovery Act. Resolution FS-09-19 is added to memorialize the Recovery Act allocation. As a result, the \$516,000 Regional Improvement Program Transportation Enhancement shares will return to Stanislaus County.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) allocate \$916,000 for two locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Transportation Enhancement (TE) projects on the State Highway System.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes two locally-administered STIP TE projects on the State Highway System for \$916,000, plus \$2,070,000 from local sources. The local agencies are ready to proceed with these projects and are requesting an allocation at this time.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that ~~\$870,120~~ **\$354,120** be allocated from the Budget Act of 2008, Budget Act Item 2660-301-0890, ~~and~~ \$45,880 from Non-Budget Act Item 2660-801-3008, **and \$516,000 from 2008 Non-Budget Act Item 2660-807-0890** for the two locally-administered STIP TE projects described on the attached vote list.
