RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission), as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-10-61

ISSUE:

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration (ND) has been completed:

- Sand Canyon Avenue in Orange County. Construct a new equipment service center on Sand Canyon Avenue in the city of Irvine. (PPNO 2109)

This project in Orange County will construct a new equipment service center on Sand Canyon Avenue in the city of Irvine. The project is not fully funded. The project is programmed on the State Highway Operation Protection Program Long Lead List. Construction is proposed to start in Fiscal Year 2012-13. Total estimated project cost is \$27,000,000.

A copy of the MND has been provided to Commission staff. No negative environmental impacts are anticipated from the project. As a result, an ND was completed for this project.
