Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. The facility is safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3769 – 05-SBt-156U-PM 9.13/9.22
(Request No. 8835) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Hollister on Route 156U (San Juan Road), being the city's portion of the San Benito River Bridge, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The City, by resolution dated April 5, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3770 – 06-Ker-14-PM 20.99/23.73
(Request No. 85323) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of California City along Route 14, on Pesche Boulevard, California City Boulevard, and Leiman Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by controlled access highway agreement dated June 7, 2005, and by cooperative agreement dated January 4, 2005, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3771 – 08-SBd-71-PM R3.43/R6.01
(Request No. 412-S) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Chino Hills along Route 71 between Chino Hills Parkway and Pine Avenue, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated June 14, 1994, and by letter dated June 9, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3772 – 12-Ora-5-PM 35.2/37.0
(Request No. R120024) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 between the southerly city limits and South Harbor Boulevard, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by letter dated June 14, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
