## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission allocate \$210,000 State Route 99 (SR 99) Corridor bond Program funds for the Los Molinos project (PPNO 3326) in Tehama County.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes one State administered Proposition 1B SR 99 Corridor bond project on the State Highway System for \$210,000. These funds were made available from construction contract award savings from the initial allocation and contingent upon approval of concurrent SR 99 Corridor bond baseline amendment Resolution R99-PA-1011-002. The County of Tehama is ready to proceed with this project and is requesting and allocation at this time.

## **RESOLUTION:**

Be it resolved, that \$210,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2009, Budget Act Item 2660-304-6072 for one State Administered State Route 99 Corridor bond project described on the attached list.
