Subject: **PROPOSITION 1B LETTERS OF NO PREJUDICE**
RESOLUTION LONP1B-A-1011-08

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve two Letters of No Prejudice (LONP), available under Assembly Bill (AB) 672, for the project identified on the attached spreadsheet.

ISSUE:

Due to the unavailability of Proposition 1B funds, the City of Inglewood is requesting AB 672 authority to substitute Traffic Light Synchronization Program (TLSP) funds with other funds for construction of a programmed project in order to keep the project on schedule.

The City of Inglewood project will improve traffic flow, reduce delay and improve air quality on the La Brea Avenue corridor.

Due to the unavailability of Proposition 1B funds, the San Bernardino Associated Governments is requesting AB 672 authority to substitute Traffic Light Synchronization Program (TLSP) funds with other funds for construction of a programmed project in order to keep the project on schedule.

The San Bernardino Associated Governments project will improve traffic flow, reduce delay and improve air quality on the San Bernardino Valley Coordinated Traffic Signal System, Tier 3 & 4 corridor.

BACKGROUND

Government Code Section 14556.33 allows an applicant agency that is either a regional or local entity, to seek approval of a LONP. If approved by the Commission, the LONP allows the applicant agencies to expend its own funds for any component of the transportation project, and seek allocation and reimbursement from the TLSP in the future.

RESOLUTION LONP1B-A-1011-08:

Resolved, with all conditions stipulated still in effect, the California Transportation Commission hereby approves a Letter of No Prejudice (LONP) for two projects programmed in, or otherwise funded from the Traffic Light Synchronization Program (TLSP) in accordance with the attached project list; and

Be it Further Resolved, that each agency understands that they proceed at its own risk, as reimbursement is dependent on future availability of TLSP funding; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the project component covered by an approved LONP should be ready to proceed to contract award (or equivalent) once the LONP is approved; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the agency shall report to the Department within four months following LONP approval on progress in executing agreements and third-party contracts needed to execute the work.
