Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3781 – 03-Pla-193-PM 0.00/1.35
(Request No. 035759-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Lincoln on Route 193 (McBean Park Drive and the Lincoln Newcastle Highway) from Route 65 to the easterly city limits, under terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment agreement dated October 1, 2008, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 362, Statutes of 2006, which amended Section 493 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution R-3782 – 04-Ala-238-PM 15.0/15.4
(Request No. 56030) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Alameda along Route 238, on Westerman Court, Morrill Street, and Langton Way, consisting of collateral facilities. The County, by freeway agreement dated October 20, 1992, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State, and by letter dated August 31, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement.

Resolution R-3783 – 06-Ker-14-PM 17.12/23.58
(Request No. 86315) – 8 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Kern along Route 14 between 4.2 miles south and 2.3 miles north of California City Boulevard, consisting of superseded highway right of way and collateral facilities. The County, by cooperative agreement dated April 17, 2007, and by letter dated October 18, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3784 – 07-LA-605-PM 21.1/22.8
(Request No. 808) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Irwindale along Route 605 between West Ramona Boulevard and Rivergrade Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by relinquishment agreement dated December 8, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3785 – 08-SBd-210-PM 15.18/18.24
(Request No. 452-S) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Rialto along Route 210 between Mango Avenue and Lilac Avenue, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated January 2, 2001, and by letter dated October 14, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3786 – 12-Ora-05-PM 36.2/36.5
(Request No. R120019) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 at Katella Avenue, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired December 19, 2010, without exception.

Resolution R-3787 – 12-Ora-05-PM 38.6
(Request No. R120026) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 at the intersection of South Walnut Street and West Broadway Street, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired December 19, 2010, without exception.

Resolution R-3788 – 12-Ora-05-PM 36.5/36.7
(Request No. R120029) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 on South Anaheim Boulevard, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired December 19, 2010, without exception.

Resolution R-3789 – 12-Ora-05-PM 35.8/36.0
(Request No. R120041) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 on Gene Autry Way, Santa Cruz Street, and Stanford Court, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired October 20, 2010, without exception.

Resolution R-3790 – 12-Ora-133-PM 7.8
(Request No. R120042) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Irvine along Route 133 at Laguna Canyon Road, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by resolution dated September 28, 2010, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3791 – 10-Cal-4-PM 21.43/22.15
(Request No. 16395) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Angels along Route 4 from 98.43 feet (30 meters) east of the east end of the Angels Creek Bridge No. 30-0008 to the easterly city limits, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The City, by cooperative agreement dated November 4, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
