RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) allocate an additional \$1,900,000 for one State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) project identified below.

ISSUE:

Additional funds are needed for one previously approved project in order to award the construction contract.

RESOLUTION:


Resolved, that \$1,900,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2009, Budget Act Items 2660-302-0890 and 2660-302-0042 to provide additional funds for the project identified below.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that this request for \$1,900,000 be approved to allow this project to be awarded.



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project is located in Alameda County on Route 880 in Oakland from 0.5 mile north of High Street to 0.5 mile south of Fifth Avenue. Route 880 is the fifth most congested freeway corridor in the San Francisco Bay Area. It is a major route for both commuters and goods movement to and from the Port of Oakland and the Oakland International Airport. This project will rehabilitate the pavement on the mainline and ramps. The scope of work includes replacing deteriorated concrete slabs and grinding slabs roadway sections, crack and seat pavement, place Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, overlay with asphalt concrete, and replacing metal beam guard rail with concrete barrier.

FUNDING STATUS:

The project was programmed in the 2008 State Highway Operations Protection Program (SHOPP) for \$5,000,000 for construction in FY 2009-10. In April 2010, funds were allocated for the programmed amount. Bids were opened on October 5, 2010. Four bids were received for this project. The amount needed to award, based on the lowest responsible bid is \$6,829,000. This request is for \$1,900,000, 38 percent over the vote amount, to award this contract.

REASONS FOR COST INCREASE: The Department performed a bid analysis to determine all significant differences between the Engineer's Estimate and the contract bid items. The contract has 19 bid items. Four of these bid items have significant cost differences.

The potential and actual bidders for this contract were contacted to discuss the reasons for the bid amounts of the items listed above. The main reasons cited were:

- o Difficulty replacing concrete slabs on this highly congested portion of Route 880. Most of the work must be performed at night and weekends due to the restrictive lane closure requirements.
- o Special events in the area (Oracle Arena and Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum) may restrict lane closures.
- o There are insufficient shoulders to effectively stage the construction operations.
- o New specifications for sealing the new concrete slabs resulted in higher bid prices for the bid items, Replace Concrete Pavement and Repair Spalled Joints.

The combination of these factors makes the replacement of the concrete slabs more difficult to construct and therefore resulted in the higher bid prices for these contract items.

An additional \$1,900,000 in supplemental funds is needed in order to award this project.

FUNDING OPTIONS:

OPTION A: Approve this request, as presented above, for \$1,900,000 to allow this project to be awarded.

OPTION B: Deny this request and direct the Department to reject all bids, retain current scope of the project, and re-advertise. The Department has considered this option and determined that there is no guarantee of having adequate number of bidders or lower price bids in the future, and this option would further delay this pavement rehabilitation project.

OPTION C: Deny this request and direct the Department to revise the project to remain within the allocated amount and re-advertise the project. The Department has considered this option and determined that reducing the scope of work on this project, and executing another project to complete the deleted work later would result in greater cost and more disruption to the traveling public.

RECOMMENDED OPTION:

The Department recommends that this request for \$1,900,000, as presented in Option A, above, be approved to award the project to the low bidder.
