RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) defer an allocation of \$22,296,000 for the locally administered Multi-funded Proposition 1B project for Route 198 (from Route 99 to Plaza Drive) in Tulare County programmed in the Corridor Mobility Improvement Account (CMIA)/State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

ISSUE:

The attached vote list describes one locally administered CMIA/STIP project for \$22,296,000. Although the Department is ready to proceed with this project, it is recommended that the Commission defer this allocation until sufficient bond proceeds become available.
