Subject: **TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO PREVIOUSLY APPROVED RESOLUTION -
RESOLUTION FP-07-72**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve a technical correction to Resolution FP-07-72, originally approved May 29, 2008, which allocated \$496,000 to two locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program projects on the State Highway System.

ISSUE:

A technical correction is needed for Project 2 - Route 1 and Harmony Valley Road Landscape Mitigation project (PPNO 0380Y) in San Luis Obispo County. The Route 1 and Harmony Valley Road Landscape Mitigation project has a five-year landscape monitoring period. Prior to allocation, San Luis Obispo County requested a seven-year period of project completion. However, this request was overlooked by the Department. This technical correction changes the period of project completion for the Route 1 and Harmony Valley Road Landscape Mitigation project from three years to seven years.

The required changes are reflected in strikethrough and bold on the attachment.

ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM
RESOLUTION FP-07-72**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following resolution, allocating \$496,000 for two locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects on the State Highway System.

ISSUE:

The attached vote list describes two locally-administered STIP projects on the State Highway System totaling \$496,000, plus \$600,000 from other sources. The agencies for these projects are ready to proceed and are requesting an allocation at this time. **The County of San Luis Obispo requests a seven-year period of project completion for project number 2.**

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that \$496,000 be allocated from Non-Budget Act Item 2660-801-3008 for two locally-administered STIP projects, as described on the attached vote list.
