Subject: **FINANCIAL ALLOCATION FOR STATE ADMINISTERED CORRIDOR MOBILITY IMPROVEMENT ACCOUNT PROJECTS ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM RESOLUTION CMIA-A-1112-016**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) allocate \$78,147,000 for two State administered Proposition 1B Corridor Mobility Improvement Account (CMIA) Program projects.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes two State administered CMIA projects for \$78,147,000, plus \$18,800,000 from local sources. The Department is ready to proceed with these projects and is requesting an allocation at this time.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$78,147,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2011, Budget Act Item 2660-304-6055 and 2660-004-6055 for two State administered Proposition 1B Corridor Mobility Improvement Account projects described on the attached vote list.

Be it Further Resolved, that as a condition of allocation of these funds and to perform its administrative role established by Senate Bill 88, the Commission requests that the Department perform the functions necessary to ensure proper accountability measures are employed and reporting requirements are met for the Proposition 1B Corridor Mobility Improvement Program.
