Ref: **APPROVAL OF PROJECT FOR CONSIDERATION OF ROUTE ADOPTION AND FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING, ROUTE ADOPTING A CONTROLLED ACCESS HIGHWAY IN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, RESOLUTION NUMBER E-03-21**

ISSUE:

The attached resolution proposes to approve, for consideration of route adoption and future consideration of funding, the following project for which a Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) has been completed:

- Route 1 in San Mateo County – Route Adopting a Controlled Access Highway.

The project is fully funded in the 2002 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for a total of \$164,700,000. The project is funded from \$157,200,000 of Federal Emergency Relief Funds, \$6,000,000 of Federal Demonstration Funds, and \$750,000 each of Regional Improvement Program (RIP) and Interregional Improvement Program (IIP) funds. Construction is scheduled to begin in FY 2003/04.

The FEIR has been transmitted to California Transportation Commission staff.

The Department of Transportation (Department) has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the FEIR with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-03-21.
