Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **ISSUE:**

The collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishment a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the summary.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolution:

### Resolution No. R-3554 – 09-Iny-395-PM 90.9/99.6 (Request No. 208) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Inyo, between South Fish Springs Road and Big Pine Dump Road, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads, and frontage roads. The County of Inyo, by controlled access highway agreement dated April 6, 1999, and by Board Order dated March 11, 2003, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the Department and by letter dated March 15, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the Department.
