RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following resolution, allocating ~~\$22,634,000~~ **\$22,265,000** for ~~five~~ **four** State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects off the State Highway System.

ISSUE:

The attached list describes ~~five~~ **four** locally-administered STIP projects off the State Highway System totaling ~~\$22,634,000~~ **\$22,265,000**, plus ~~\$34,032,036~~ **\$30,527,000** from other sources. The agencies for these projects are ready to proceed and are requesting an allocation at this time.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that ~~\$22,634,000~~ **\$22,265,000** be allocated from Non-Budget Act Item 2660-601-3093 for ~~five~~ **four** locally-administered STIP projects, as described on the attached vote list.
