**Subject:** **UPDATE ON PROJECTS VOTED BUT NOT AWARDED**

## **SUMMARY:**

The California Department of Transportation (Department) is presenting this item for information on the status of State Highway Operation and Protection Program projects, State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects, and Proposition 1B bond projects where the California Transportation Commission has allocated funds but the implementing agency has not yet awarded a construction contract. The attached spreadsheets include:

- VNA Attachment 2 – Locally Administered Off System Projects (Non-bond)
- VNA Attachment 3 – Proposition 1B Bond Projects, On and Off System

## **SUMMARY:**

The California Department of Transportation (Department) is presenting this item for information on the status of State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and Proposition 1B bond projects that have been delivered (deemed ready to go), but due to financial constraints of the State, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) has been unable to allocate funds to enable the implementing agencies to award the projects.

With the passage of the State budget and the availability of State Highway Account funds, projects programmed in the State Highway Operation and Protection Program that are ready for vote will be submitted to the Commission for allocation at the its April 15-16, 2009 meeting.

The attached list of STIP and Proposition 1B projects is arranged by project category and then by county. These projects are in no particular priority order. The total value for the projects on the attached list ~~\$709,655,000~~ **\$576,730,000**.
