





High Desert Corridor (HDC) Project

- Parallels SR-138 from Antelope Valley (Los Angeles County) to Victor Valley (San Bernardino County)
- New Freeway/ Expressway with Possible Toll Facility
- Total est. Cost: \$6 Billion (esc.)

- HDC JPA Oversight Agency
- Metro/Caltrans Lead Environmental Clearance
- SCAG, SanBAG, Antelope Valley/Victor Valley Cities Providing Technical Input/Outreach Support
- Federal/Local Funding

Public Private Partnership (PPP)

- HDC One of Six Initial High Potential Projects Approved by Metro Board
- Developing Business Case Model/Strategic Assessment (Summer 2010)
- Initiating Environmental Clearance (Completion est. 2013)

Goods Movement

- Provides LA Basin Bypass for I-15 to I-5 via SR-14 and SR-58
- Integrates Work Underway on East/West Ends
- Relieves Traffic Congestion/Improves Air Quality/Promotes Economic Development
