Subject: **FINANCIAL ALLOCATION FOR LOCALLY-ADMINISTERED TRANSIT PROGRAM
PROJECTS OFF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM (ADVANCEMENT)
RESOLUTION MFP-10-07**

CTC ACTION UPDATE: The California Transportation Commission approved the allocation request for the local STIP transit project (PPNO 04-2174C), described on the attached vote list and contingent upon the passage of the 2010 Budget Act .

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) defer an allocation of \$16,000,000 for one locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Transit project (Advancement).

The Department recommends deferral due to insufficient allocation capacity in the Public Transportation Account for all programmed projects, subject to adoption of an allocation plan by the Commission.

ISSUE:

The attached vote list describes one locally-administered STIP Transit project (Advancement) for \$16,000,000. Although the local agency is ready to proceed with this project, it is recommended that the Commission defer this allocation until an allocation plan is adopted by the Commission.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:

Resolved, that \$16,000,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2010, Budget Act Item 2660-101-0046 for the locally-administered STIP project described on the attached vote list contingent on the passage of the 2010 Budget Act.
