Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolutions in the county where the facilities are located, all rights, title and interest of the State in and to the facilities to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agencies identified in the summary. The facilities are safe and drivable. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution R-3846 – 04-Ala-84-PM M27.8/R28.6
(Request No. 56106) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Livermore on Route 84 (Airway Boulevard), from Isabel Avenue to Route 580, consisting of highway right of way superseded by a transfer of state highway location. The City, by resolution dated May 15, 2012, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution R-3847– 06-Fre-180-PM 66.05
(Request No. 86804) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Fresno along Route 180 at Locan Avenue, consisting of collateral facilities. The County, by freeway agreement dated May 12, 2009, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired June 24, 2012, without exception.

Resolution R-3848 – 12-Ora-5-PM 35.6
(Request No. R120049) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 on Santa Cruz Boulevard, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired July 10, 2012, without exception.

Resolution R-3849 – 12-Ora-5-PM 40.4/40.6
(Request No. R120031) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 on Fir Avenue, Ivy Lane, Maple Street, Holly Street, and Catalpa Avenue, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired July 10, 2012, without exception.

Resolution R-3850 – 12-Ora-5-PM 35.6/35.9
(Request No. R120034) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 on Anaheim Way, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired July 10, 2012, without exception.

Resolution R-3851 – 12-Ora-5-PM 38.1
(Request No. R120036) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 on Illinois Street, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired July 10, 2012, without exception.

Resolution R-3852 – 12-Ora-5-PM 39.7/39.8
(Request No. R120037) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Anaheim along Route 5 on Westmont Drive, consisting of collateral facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired July 10, 2012, without exception.

Resolution R-3853 – 04-CC-680-PM 13.3/15.7
(Request No. 56058) – 10 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the city of Walnut Creek along Route 680 between Lancaster Road and San Luis Road, consisting of collateral and nonmotorized transportation facilities. The City, by freeway agreement dated September 22, 1987 and by freeway agreement dated October 27, 1987, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The City, by resolution dated July 17, 2012, agrees to accept the relinquishment and waive the 90-Day requirement.
