**Approval of Traffic Congestion Relief Program**  
**Project Applications**

**RESOLUTION TA-01-17**

- 1.1 WHEREAS the Traffic Congestion Relief Act of 2000 (herein after referred to as "statute"), which was established by Chapters 91 (AB 2928) and 656 (SB 1662) of the Statutes of 2000, establishes the Traffic Congestion Relief Program, providing \$5.39 billion for projects throughout the State of California to reduce traffic congestion, provide for safe and efficient movement of goods, and provide system connectivity; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS in accordance with Government Code Section 14556.11 the California Transportation Commission (Commission) has adopted guidelines, in consultation with the Department of Transportation (Department) and regional agencies, to implement the Traffic Congestion Relief Program (TCRP); and
- 1.3 WHEREAS the statute and guidelines require applicants to specify full and complete project applications, including scope, cost and schedule, financial plans and funding sources; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS the Commission, with assistance from the Department, is required by statute to review and approve applications for TCRP projects that meet the requirements in statute and guidelines; and
- 1.5 WHEREAS the Commission, with assistance from the Department, has reviewed submitted TCRP project applications, and subsequent clarifications and revisions, and determined they comply with the statute and guidelines.
- 2.1 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Commission does hereby approve the following five TCRP project applications for \$16,450,000 as submitted, with subsequent clarifications and revisions:
- Project #19 - \$150,000, Phase 1 for Bay Area Water Transit Authority; establish a regional water transit system beginning with Treasure Island in the City and County of San Francisco.  
 Applicant Agency: Bay Area Water Transit Authority (BAWTA)  
 Implementing Agency: BAWTA  
 Advance Requested: \$150,000
  - Project #25.2 - \$3,000,000, Phase 1 for I-80/I-680/Route 12 Interchange in Fairfield in Solano County; 12 interchange complex in seven stages (Stage 1) - **North Connector, Mengels Extension.**  
 Applicant Agency: Solano Transportation Authority (STA)  
 Implementing Agency: STA  
 Advance Requested: \$300,000

- Project #25.3 - \$9,000,000, Phase 1 for I-80/I-680/Route 12 Interchange in Fairfield in Solano County; 12 interchange complex in seven stages (Stage 1) - **I-80/680 Interchange.**  
Applicant Agency: Solano Transportation Authority (STA)  
Implementing Agency: STA  
Advance Requested: \$400,000
- Project #46 - \$1,300,000, Phase 3 for Route 1; reconstruct intersection at Route 107 in Torrance in Los Angeles County.  
Applicant Agency: California Department of Transportation (Caltrans)  
Implementing Agency: Caltrans
- Project #99.1 - \$3,000,000, Phase 3, 4 for San Joaquin Corridor: track and signals along San Joaquin intercity rail line in seven counties - **Bowles to Calwa.**  
Applicant Agency: California Department of Transportation (Caltrans)  
Implementing Agency: Caltrans

- 2.2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for Project #46 – Route 1; reconstruct intersection at Route 107 in Torrance, the allocation of funds for right of way is contingent upon review and approval for future consideration of funding, of the final environmental document by the CTC; and
- 2.3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this TCRP project application approval by the Commission reserves the State funding for these projects as specified by the statute, and allows the applicant agencies to incur costs in accordance with the approved project application, statute and guidelines.
