REINTEGRATION OF FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS INTO
THE STIP PROCESS

RESOLUTION G-03-13

Replacing Resolution G-00-18

WHEREAS the Commission adopted a separate Federal Enhancement (TEA) Program Under TEA-21 by passing Resolution G-98-20 in October 1998; and

WHEREAS the Commission replaced Resolution G-98-20 by passing Resolution G-00-18 on July 20, 2000; and

WHEREAS the Commission now intends to reintegrate the federal Transportation Enhancement (TE) funds back into the STIP process.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission reintegrates the TEA Program back into the STIP starting with federal TE funds made available with the upcoming 2003 federal transportation act reauthorization.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any TEA projects programmed or allocated with ISTEA or TEA-21 era federal enhancement funds will continue to be administered under the separate Federal Enhancement TEA program as outlined in Commission Resolution G-98-20 until the projects are constructed or lapse their funds dues to timely use of funds issues.
