Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 48 to California's 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the rural, non-MPO portion of the FSTIP. These changes are submitted as an administrative modification. The changes are within the quadrennial element; do not reflect a change in the design concept or scope of the project, or impact financial constraints. Funding is available for these modifications. In addition, there are no projects in this Administrative Modification No. 48 that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review. Modifications are made to the following projects:

- BIKEPED – Bicycle Pedestrian Facilities Grouped Project Listing for Non Attainment Counties. This modification adjusts the funding for the Nevada County Government Center Walkway Connection project. Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) funding was decreased in Fiscal Year (FY) 2009/10 by \$30,000 and local funds were reduced by \$3,000.
- Funding for the following CMAQ projects in Mariposa County has been changed to 100 percent CMAQ as allowed under the Toll Credit Use Policy: CMAQRD - Diesel Engine Retrofit in Mariposa County, REGENERAT – Thermal Regenerator and Pulse Cleaner, ROLLOFFTR –Retrofit Roll Off Truck, TRKTRLR – Retrofit Truck/Trailer.
