Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Please accept for your review and approval Administrative Modification #29 to SACOG's 2009/12 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP). SACOG staff made the requested changes for the attached project using the authority delegated to staff by the SACOG Board of Directors to process administrative modifications to the MTIP. The proposed change will not impact SACOG's financial constraint or the region's air quality conformity.

Administrative Modification #29 revises CAL17660, Sutter Route 99 Corridor Widening to exchange one type of funding for another. Amendment #29 would program \$2.5 million in State Highway Operations and Protection Program (SHOPP) American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding, and reduce Proposition 1B (SR 99 Corridor) State Bond funding by \$2.5 million. These ARRA funds come from a cost savings Caltrans experienced on another project outside our region.

I would appreciate your expeditious review and approval of the enclosed modification. Upon your approval, this modification will be effective immediately.
