- Adds, modifies or deletes various projects from various funding programs in El Dorado, Placer, Sacramento, Sutter, Yolo and Yuba Counties. The amendment includes projects with funding from Proposition 1B State Bond, State Transportation Improvement Program, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality, High Priority Project, Regional Surface Transportation Program, Safe Routes to School and various Federal Transit Administration (FTA) programs.



I also recommend that Federal Highway Administration and FTA approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2009 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FSTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of projects for federal funding.
