The California Department of Transportation has completed the review of the following amendment to the San Diego Association of Governments' (SANDAG) 2008/09-2012/13 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

Adds and modifies various projects from various funding programs in San Diego County. The amendment includes projects with funding from the State Highway Operation and Protection Program, High Priority Program, State Transportation Improvement Program, Highway Bridge Program, Safe Routes to School Program, and the Federal Transit Administration 5311 Program.

The SANDAG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is consistent with the Regional Transportation Plan, is financially constrained, is consistent with the regional emission analysis, does not affect timely implementation of the transportation control measures, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by SANDAG

I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2009 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP).
