**SUBJECT: Administrative Modification #20 to the 2009 Federal
Transportation Improvement Program**

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Enclosed please find the documentation in support of Administrative Modification #20 to the SJCOG 2009 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). The SJCOG Executive Director has the authority to approve all administrative modifications. State approval is required; however Federal approval is not required.

The proposed modifications are consistent with the 2007 Regional Transportation Plan and the Public Participation Plan adopted by the SJCOG Board.

FTIP Administrative Modification #20 amends the following project in the 2009 FTIP:

- (1) Various Agencies, Pavement and Resurfacing Grouped Projects (CTIPS ID# 212-0000-0001) adds "San Joaquin County near Discovery Bay from Old River Bridge to Middle River Bridge, Maintenance Asphalt Concrete Overlay" Project to the Lump Sum List, and adds \$1,088,919 in Highway Maintenance - STP funds in FY 09/10 and \$141,081 in State Cash in FY 09/10. (3% increase in programming)


These changes are consistent with the description of "Minor changes" in the "Revised Federal – Statewide Transportation Improvement Program
