The California Department of Transportation has completed the review of the following amendment to the Tahoe Metropolitan Planning Organization's (TMPO) 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

No. Description

1 **Financial Element**

- The amendment updates the FTIP financial plan to include estimated revenue for the TMPO region based on the proposed American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The amendment adds \$3,000,000 in the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funds and \$250,000 in the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funds respectively as revenue in the Fiscal Year 2008/09.

TMPO has certified that the amendment is financially constrained and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by TMPO.
