Enclosed for your review and approval is TCAG's Administrative Modification Amendment No. 14 to the 2009 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). Amendment No. 14 to the 2009 FTIP modifies one currently programmed project by correcting the local funding match by component to 10 percent local and 90 percent federal. there is no total project funding increase or decrease and is considered a TYPE I Administrative Modification (Amendment) to the 2009 FTIP.

Amendment No. 14 corrects the component cost to match the 10 percent/90 percent rule for TUL08-140 "Golden Valley Elementary Scholl: Construct 5, 40 lineal feet of Curb, gutter and sidewalk around the entire perimeter of the campus on Ave 416, Ave 413, Rd 126, and Rd 127." The overall project cost does not change with this modification request.

This currently programmed project is included in the Conformity Analysis for the 2009 Interim FTIP Amendment No. 3 and 2007 RTP Amendment No. 1 and no further conformity determination is required. This amendment does not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved Transportation Control Measures (TCMs). This CMAQ project is exempt from Air Quality conformity analysis. Amendment No. 14 to the 2009 FTIP meets all applicable transportation planning requirements per 23 CFR Part 450 and 40 CFR Part 93.
