Dear Mr. Hannon and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits for your review and approval Amendment No. ~~18~~²¹ to the Rural, Non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) area portion of the California 2013 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). I am also recommending that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration approve this amendment for inclusion into California's 2013 FSTIP.

Amendment No. ~~18~~²¹ to the 2013 FSTIP modifies four (4) existing projects and adds seven (7) new Highway Bridge Program (HBP) projects as described in *Attachment 1, Summary of Changes and CTIPS Listing*.

State and Local Elements*Amador County:*

Proj 1: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0334, BR #26C0026, Bell Road over Big Indian Creek – Program additional \$778,000 of HBP funds in Fiscal Year (FY) 12/13 and 15/16.

Proj 2: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0335, BR #260042, Old Amador Road over Rancheria Creek – Program additional \$696,000 of HPB funds in various FYs and modify delivery schedule.

Calaveras County:

Proj 3: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0394, BR #30C0065, Rolleri Bypass Road over Angels Creek – Program right of way phase from prior year to FY 15/16 and modify the construction delivery schedule to the future year outside of the current FSTIP period.

Various Counties:

Proj 4: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0146, Grouped project listing for activities that do not lead to construction for federally mandated Bridge Inspection Program – Program additional \$11.2million of HBP and other funds in FY 13/14 and 15/16.

Mariposa County:

Proj 5: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0401, BR #40C0060, Oak Road over Bear Creek – Program a new HBP project to replace existing one-lane bridge with two-lane. This project is not regionally significant and exempt from air quality conformity requirement.

Nevada County:

Projects 6-11: Program six (6) new HBP projects in various locations to replace existing structurally deficient one-lane bridges with new two-lane bridges. These projects were determined to be not regionally significant and are exempt from air quality conformity requirements.

This amendment was made available for public review and comment for fourteen (14) days which began on December 4, 2013 and concluded on December 18, 2013. No comments were received during the public review and comment period. The financial impact of this amendment is compatible with the anticipated revenues in the 2013 FSTIP Financial Plan and remains financially constrained as demonstrated in *Attachment 2, Financial Summary Tables*. In addition, there are no projects in this amendment that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Based upon correspondence from FHWA dated May 27, 2008, projects in non-metropolitan isolated non-attainment areas of the State do not need to meet project conformity to be included in the FSTIP. However, such projects must comply with project level conformity requirements when a Federal action such as a National Environmental Protection Agency decision or obligation of funds, is taken on the project.

Projects in this amendment with funding beyond the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP are included for information only. These projects are included and submitted by Caltrans through the California Transportation Improvement Program System (CTIPS). In addition to being available in CTIPS, programming pages for each project are also enclosed for your ready reference.

Please note that the approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of projects for federal funding.
