

JACK JARNAGHAN RODEO GROUNDS



The Jack Jarnaghan Rodeo Grounds opened in 1977. The 16-plus acre facility sits along the Trinity River and hosts the annual Hoopa Rodeo, welcoming participants from across the nation.

Improvements from the grant will install a new security system, fencing throughout grounds, upgrade the water/irrigation system, add a new bathroom, storage container, and 500-gallon water wagon.

New arena footing will be added, along with a new livestock barn, Rhino steel building covered arena, new covered bleachers, ADA paved parking lot, picnic tables, and new barbecue grill.



In addition, a new pergola, lighting throughout the grounds, large cement planters and landscaping, interpretive signage, artwork, and a memorial plaque.
