Step 5	Approved DDO/DO is sent to functional units

Step 6	Contractor signs contract and package prepared for DPAC
Step 7	RE coordinates material procurement and work schedule with contractor
Step 8	CT Construction submits completed contract package to Major Damage Coordinator
Step 9	Major Damage Coordinator submits complete contract package to DPAC
Step 10	DPAC executes contract and CT Construction Support pays approved estimates

Department of Industrial Relations MANDATORY Registration as of April 1, 2015

Senate Bill 854, establishes a new public works program to replace the Compliance Monitoring Unit and Labor Compliance Program requirements for bond-funded and other public works projects. The new program will cover all Public Works jobs in the state rather than just selected categories of projects.

All Contractors and all their Sub-Contractors must be registered with the DIR to be able to do any type of Public Works jobs in the State.

Contractors must register and pay the **\$400** annual fee and meet requirements using the new online application at <u>https://www.dir.ca.gov/Public-Works/Contractor-Registration.html</u> before bidding on public works contracts in California. The application also provides agencies that administer public works programs with a searchable database of qualified contractors.

Contractors' requirements include that they maintain worker's compensation coverage for all employees and only hire subcontractors who are registered public works contractors. They must also hold a Contractors State License Board license, if required for their trade.

In addition, contractors must not be debarred from working on public works by the state or federal government and have no delinquent wage or penalty assessments due to any enforcement agency or employee. Contractors will also be subject to penalties for bidding or working on public works without being registered with DIR.

Reconstruct pavement under emergency conditions; Excavate slopes or construct embankment; Rent heavy equipment to Caltrans on short notice; Demolish damaged structures; Remove and replace culverts or drains; Provide temporary traffic control; and others not listed

All contractors of all sizes are invited to express their interest in potentially performing emergency work for Caltrans.

When an emergency strikes, Caltrans may use emergency procedures to immediately select a contractor to reopen damaged facilities. The purpose of the registry is to provide a list of contractors potentially available for emergency work if needed.



What is the Process to Engage the California Capital PTAC?

- Businesses must first register at <u>www.cacapital.org/ptac</u> to become a client.


