

**EXTENSION OF THE FIRST AMENDED  
PROGRAMMATIC AGREEMENT AMONG THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION,  
THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON HISTORIC PRESERVATION, THE CALIFORNIA STATE HISTORIC  
PRESERVATION OFFICER, THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, AND THE  
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION  
106 OF THE NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION ACT, AS IT PERTAINS TO THE  
ADMINISTRATION OF THE FEDERAL-AID HIGHWAY PROGRAM IN CALIFORNIA**

**WHEREAS**, the *First Amended Programmatic Agreement Among the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the Advisory Council On Historic Preservation (ACHP), the California State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO), the United States Army Corps Of Engineers (ACOE), and the California Department Of Transportation (Caltrans) Regarding Compliance With Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, as it Pertains to the Administration of the Federal-Aid Highway Program in California* (Section 106 PA) was executed on January 1, 2014, and is set to expire on December 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Signatories are in the process of renewing the Section 106 PA; and

**WHEREAS**, the Signatories agree to extend the Section 106 PA to December 31, 2024, or the execution of the Second Amended Section 106 PA, whichever comes first; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, ACHP, FHWA, SHPO, CALTRANS, and ACOE, as signatories to this PA, agree that Caltrans may continue use of the Federal Aid Highway Projects PA for Section 106 compliance.




