## Samoa Bridge Murals



### PROJECT OVERVIEW

State Route 255 crosses over Humboldt Bay spanning from Eureka to Samoa. The Samoa Bridge Murals project enhances tribal and recreational use areas in the communities by beautifying six land-based columns of the bridge.

The improvements will benefit low-income, historically excluded neighborhoods by adding value and fostering local pride through the enhancement of infrastructure that dominates the landscape. Public art also decreases litter and discourages graffiti.

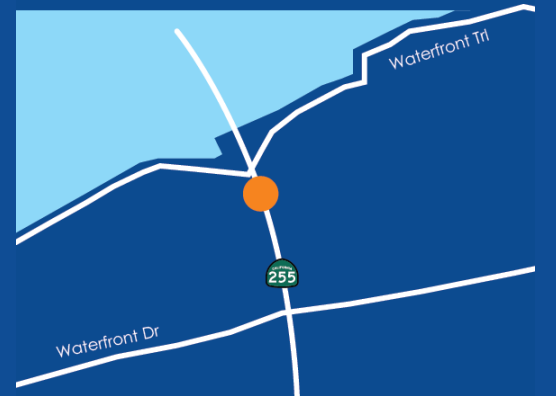
The Greater Eureka area is known for its arts community. Local artists will have the opportunity to create murals adding themes to represent and identify the people and cultures.

Partners for the project include the Wiyot Tribe and the City of Eureka. The collective effort on this project contributes to plans for future improvements.
