FACT SHEET

The Project

Caltrans, in partnership with the City of Eureka and the Humboldt County Association of Governments (HCAOG), proposes to increase comfort and safety for non-motorized users along U.S. 101/South Broadway in Eureka, and to provide better connectivity between neighborhoods and the Waterfront Trail. This project proposes to implement the preferred concept for the southern segment identified in the Eureka Broadway Multimodal Corridor Plan.

Project Benefit

The purpose of this project is to increase pedestrian and bicyclist safety, connectivity, and level of comfort, and to improve accessibility and on-time performance of the transit facility.

Project Status
