### PROJECT OVERVIEW

It is proposed to transform portions of the corridor under the State Route (SR) 4 Crosstown Freeway in Stockton, CA, providing improvements that will help restore the once vibrant cultural identity and community; reconnect the communities north and south of the Crosstown Freeway which were bisected when it was constructed.

The proposed project concept includes recreational opportunities including proposed meandering paths/walkways, a skate park, multi-generation playgrounds, places for murals, and an amphitheater for cultural events, in a historically under-served area of Stockton.

### PROJECT PURPOSE

This project proposes to transform portions of the corridor along the SR 4 (Crosstown Freeway) to revitalize the once vibrant cultural identity and life and to create a welcoming gateway to the City of Stockton.
