PROJECT OVERVIEW

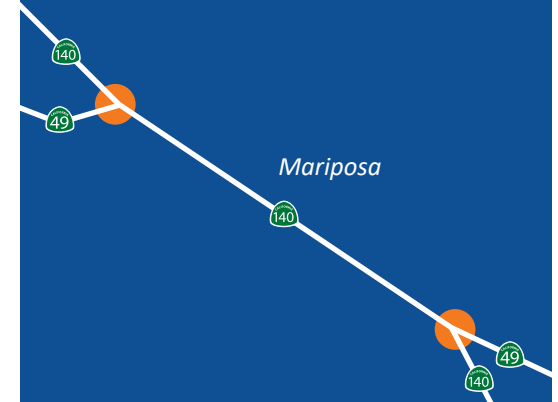
Create tribal/community themed gateway monuments on SR 140, and implement murals and portlet the historical Town of Mariposa. SR 140 passing thru Mariposa is a main entry point for millions of Yosemite Park visitors. This project will be developed in coordination with local tribe, Southern Miwuk Nation.

The gateway features will enhance the driving experience of visitors and tourists who visit and travel through Mariposa and complement the recently implemented pedestrian safety features within the Town of Mariposa, being constructed under Project 10-0Y6004. The project team will partner with Mariposa County Planning Department to help facilitate the community engagement plan, develop the project design and implement the project.
