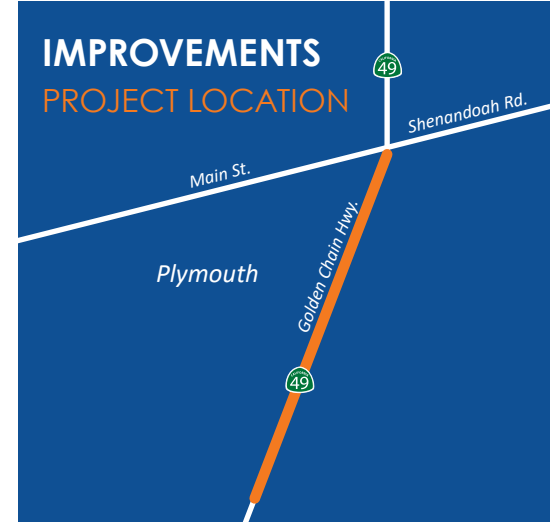




# CLEAN CALIFORNIA

## Plymouth RAB Enhancement, Gateway & Trails Project At-A-Glance



### PROJECT OVERVIEW

It is proposed to implement a project to install some unique community gateway monuments, create a landscaped trail system along SR 49 and add landscaped and transportation art elements to the existing roundabout located at the intersection of SR 49/Main Street in Plymouth, CA (originally named Pokerville). The community will be engaged to help develop these concepts and features of these long-desired community identifiers.

The project team partnered with the Town of Plymouth representatives to develop the project scope and intend to continue this partnership to help facilitate the community engagement plan, develop the project design and implement the project.
