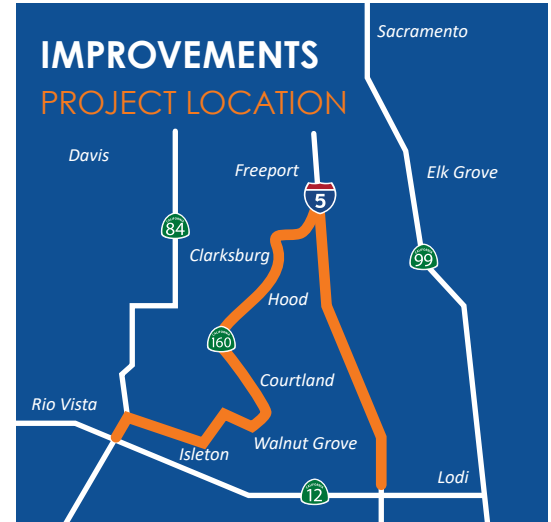

PROJECT OVERVIEW

It is proposed to install Delta wayfinding and interpretive signs at strategic points around the Delta, using the previous Delta Sign Guidelines provided by the Delta Protection Commission. The proposed comprehensive signs system will help guide visitors and help them experience the uniqueness, history and through the vast Sacramento – San Joaquin Delta Region.

There is a lack of gateway and wayfinding signs within the Delta region, resulting in visitors getting lost, but also resulting in visitors not knowing if they have entered, exited or still within the boundaries. Gateway monuments, wayfinding signs will help address this need, but also help with identifying notable places, and reinforcing the message that the Delta is a remarkable and distinctive region, with unique qualities and vibrant history.
