Repave 14 miles of SR-115 from SR-78 to SR-111.  
Cost: \$3.7 million. Begin: Summer 2017. Complete: Fall 2017.
- 2

Repave 35 miles of SR-78 from just west of Ogilby Road.  
Cost: \$10.9 million. Begin: Summer 2017. Complete: Fall 2017.
- 3

Construct new Caltrans El Centro Maintenance Yard.  
Cost: \$13.5 million. Began: Spring 2014. Completion: Summer 2017.
- 4

Interchange upgrade at I-8 and Dogwood Road.  
Cost: \$15.4 million. Began: Summer 2014. Completion: Spring 2017.
- 5

Dogwood Road landscaping and art fence.  
Cost: \$3.2 million. Begin: Spring 2017. Complete Fall 2017.
- 6

Traffic signal upgrade at SR-86 and Dogwood Road (Imperial County Permit Project).  
Cost: \$2 million. Begin: Summer 2017. Completion: Spring 2018.
- 7

SR-86 Side walk, Bus stops, Bicycle racks, and ADA work between Heffernan Ave and Heber Ave (3 contracts).  
Cost: \$800,000. Begin Spring 2017. Completion: Fall 2017
- 8

Widen SR-98 from two to four lanes from Ollie Avenue to Eady Avenue.  
Cost: \$7 million. Begin: Spring 2017. Completion: Fall 2017

- I-8 UPDATE PROJECTS

Two segments, 14 miles between SR-111 and SR-98.  
Cost: \$111.8 million. Begin: Summer 2017. Completion: Fall 2019.
- 10

From 9.5 miles east of SR-111 to SR-115.  
Cost: \$67 million. Began: Spring 2016. Completion: Summer 2017.
- 11


9.5 miles east of SR-98.  
Cost: \$65.5 million. Began: Spring 2016. Completion: Summer 2017.
- 12

From near Ogilby Road to SR-186.  
Cost: \$59.6 million. Begin: Summer 2017. Completion: Fall 2019.
- 13

From SR-186 to near Winterhaven.  
Cost: \$49 million. Began: Spring 2016. Completion: Spring 2018.

Please note that all costs and completion dates are estimated.
