Year 1 Success



State Beautification Projects

- Projects 12 Beautification/Enhancement projects conceptualized, approved, and initiated.
- Locations Projects proposed in 15 cities in D12 as well as unincorporated areas of Orange County.
- Types Culturally-themed Parks & Recreation areas, gateway monuments, murals, aesthetic treatments, pedestrian/bike trail enhancements, upgraded fencing, groundcover, and hardscaping.
- Bids 4 projects have completed advertisement and currently undergoing bid review process.

Local Grants

- Grant Agreements 3 Clean California Local Grants awarded in District 12.
- Public Events Event held on May 7, 2022 to announce Oakview Neighborhood Cleanup and Beautification project in Huntington Beach. The project will beautify and increase safety on two streets through artistic crosswalk and signages, traffic and pedestrian safety improvements and landscaping.

Litter Abatement

- Litter Collection YTD
 - 32,048 Cubic Yards currently exceeding Year 1 target by 956 cubic yards (104% of target).



Free Dump Days

- Events 6 Free Dump Days held in 2nd half of FY 21/22 within District 12. (4,245 cubic yards removed), including mattresses, E-waste, appliances, etc. Developed partnerships with Goodwill to divert gently used items from reaching the landfill and Saddleback Church to collect and donate gently used items for Ukrainian refugees.
- Locations Events held in Lake Forest (2 Events), Fullerton (2 events), Irvine and Huntington Beach.

Adopt-A-Highway

 82 AAH Year 1 D12 Adoptions: Exceeded our target by 800% with a total of 224 adoptions of 266 total adoptable sites. D12 also created GIS map to enable the general public to easily identify adoptable site locations.

Job Creation

- Statewide YTD Total Hires: 726
 Entry level Maintenance positions on board: 28 out of 44 D12 Positions filled
- Butte County Office of Education Back 2 Work program:
 - Contract amendment for 100 statewide crews for \$149.6M was fully executed on July 28, 2022.
 - 7 Clean California Back 2 Work crews were rolled out in D12 by July 2022.



Maintenance Agreements

• 2 New Clean Calif Maintenance Agreements were approved for Litter and Graffiti removal to cover portions of SR-1, SR-133 and I-5.
