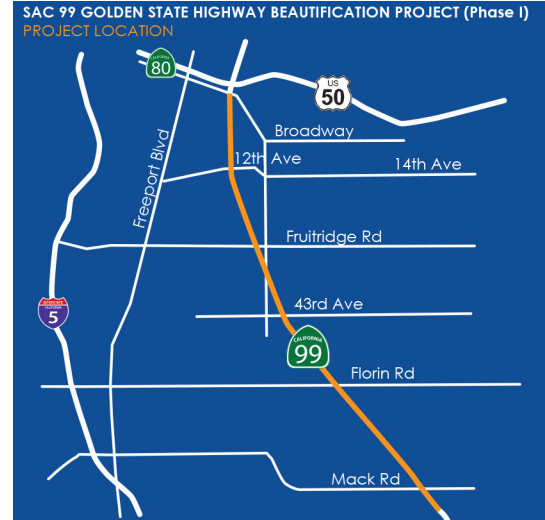
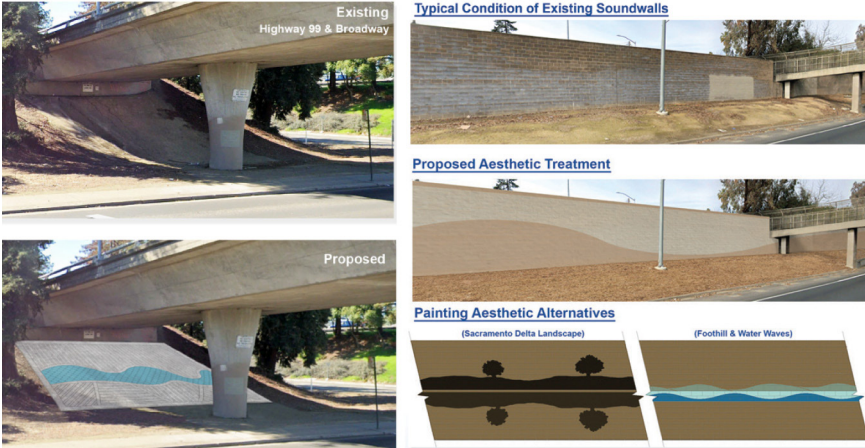

SAC 99 Golden State Highway Beautification Project (Phase I)



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The SAC 99 (Phase I) Beautification Project will improve and upgrade a 9-mile stretch of State Route 99 between the Broadway Undercrossing and the Stockton Boulevard Overcrossing in the City of Sacramento in Sacramento County. SR 99 is a main thoroughfare for South Sacramento residents and provides critical north and south connections to Downtown Sacramento and Elk Grove. SR 99 also serves as a vital interregional connection for residents, visitors, and freight to travel throughout the region. This project will advance equity for underserved communities by beautifying this area through public art and landscaping. Art in public spaces benefits the community by reducing graffiti, beautifying roadsides, and reflecting the unique identity of the community. Caltrans is working closely with the City of Sacramento Office of Arts and Culture to coordinate and engage the local Community Based Organizations to collaborate on the design concept.

- Paint the existing soundwalls/retaining wall with beautiful aesthetic features to improve the appearance of the facility to highway users at 7 locations
- Install slope paving with beautification details to enhance and modernize existing aesthetics at 10 bridges
- Install decorative gore paving to enhance visibility at 2 locations
- Install mulch and inert materials at various locations to beautify and improve the corridor
